Thoughts on Hand-Grinding Grain, Famine, Preparedness, Rain Barrels

I have attached some photos of some grains and our hand grinder. The reason for this short blog is simple. I'm talking about preparedness. Firstly, having a hand-grinder and your own grain will save you if your hydro ever goes out. You can always grind some fresh flour and make bread, pasta, or parched grains to eat, flat cakes, or whatever. Of course, you would need a source of heat such as a small gas stove or some wood for a small wood stove or grill. My preference is for wood. Secondly, grinding your own grain and making your own flour and baked items ensures that you know EXACTLY what is going into your baked stuff, and that it is fresh and healthy.
