That method can still be used, but make sure there is a cover on the rain barrel with only a hole for the eavesdrop. Then take out the water with a bucket and distil it or heat it for whatever you are using it for.

When Alish'bai was growing up in Jamaica, her family used to gather and use rain water for dishes, laundry, bathing, gardening and give water to the animals. Rain water has a very light taste also, almost like reverse osmosis. The person who wrote to the local Cambridge newspaper stated that he used it for laundry, dishwashing, watering the garden, and bathing.
