This was a recent email I sent to someone who was honestly questioning the issue of the New Testament and Yeshua/Jesus. I pray it will be helpful to others as well.

I'm glad that you have been able to see my point. And while you believe in Yeshua/Jesus, you are honest enough to say that you are questioning the matter. You would have been more than welcome to come back to my chat room and ask any and all questions you may have had, or to hear me speak to the matter of how hard it was for our family and others to reject the New Testament. Perhaps this has been coming for a long time for you. For my wife and I, it took about 5 years before we were finally ready and open enough to ask Abba if it was blasphemy to pray in the name and blood of Yeshua/Jesus, and to believe in his priesthood on our behalf as opposed to the priesthood of L'wi (Levi) which YaH said is forever. We also wondered how Y'shr'Al could be the bride of the Most High, divorced by the Most High, and promised to be re-married by the Most High, and yet the Most High would break His own marital laws? Would the Most High give HIS wife to some "Anointed Son/Yeshua/Jesus?" I know I wouldn't give my wife to my son. That is abomination according to TaNaK as well. Does YaH change and abrogate His own marital laws? Feel free to talk with us regarding these matters, and respond to any articles on our website section in this regard. You are very welcome for the recommendations I have provided, and it would be great if you could join with us regularly to read the TaNaK and see its depths in the original text as we did this past Sh'bayt (Sabbath). I can see that you have already repented of much and given the TaNaK a priority over the New Testament. Perhaps it is time to move further in your walk with YaH. By the way, Y'shaiYahu (Isa.) 44:6 is only one of many similar statements the prophet has made. See also 43:1-16; 45:14-23 (vs. 23 contradicts Philippians 2:10-11); 49:26; 60:14-20. This is only the prophet Y'shaiYahu (Isa.). YaH is great, and He alone is to be exalted and praised... He can grant you forgiveness and redemption without any need for a person to be whipped, nailed and speared because of your transgressions. Repent and follow YaH alone and His TaNaK (OT) is what I pray you will soon see. And I say that with honesty and love, knowing how hard that is.
