Very few people will speak to the subject of homosexuals, bisexuals and transsexuals. I do not have a lot of time, but I did want to make a note on the subject. They will say that the transsexual was born a lady in a male’s body and naturally had a desire to change their body into the opposite sex. But the truth is that this is all modern confused thinking. Ancient cultures understood that these things are the abnormality/deviation of society, even without the Turah (Scriptures) telling them so. It was one of the downfalls of Greco-Roman society and of numerous societies, and it will be the downfall of modern societies again. People are not born as transgressors. Transgressions are learned behaviours that are engrained or trained by environment and people’s deviations.
